#### Dr. Ronald Scott McDowell Biography

Ronald Scott McDowell is a sculptor and painter who has earned several commendations and awards. He is known for his life-like pictorials intended to master the range of human emotion and capture the essence of the human spirit.

Ronald is one of the most talented arrists in the world. With nearly 2,000 original works to his credit, McDowell is a painter, an illustrator, a portraitist, a muralist, a sculptor and a poet.

McDowell, having received national notoriety for his artwork over the course of several decades, has earned international acclaim in the past 10 years for his

Commissioned by Mayor Arrington of the City of Birmingham, Alabama in 1996 to provide a rendition of the life-like experiences of the people of Birmingham during the 60's, McDowell produced "The Salute to the Foot Soldiers" which is dedicated to those who led the march on Civil Rights under Dr. Martin Luther

Since this famous rendition, which sits in the Kelly Ingram Park across from the National Civil Rights Institute in the City of Birmingham, McDowell has now hundreds of sculptors to his credit along with thousands of paintings.

McDowell has been featured in many national news magazines, newspapers and has made numerous public appearances during the course of his career. He currently serves as the Artist for the Jazz Hall of Fame, the Alabama Music Hall of Fame, the Multicultural Center, the Birmingham Black Barons Negro League Baseball Hall of Fame and is Artist-in-Residence for the city of Tuskegee.

He has also been commissioned by some of the most notable people in world affairs and entertainment to render portraits, including, Nelson Mandela, Desmond Tutu, Barry Gordy, Michael Jackson, Diana Ross, Rosie Greer, Elvis Presley, Lionel Ritchie. AG. Gaston, Eddie Kendrick and Cecil Fielder, just to name a few. In October of 2005, McDowell's works were featured and presented to host, Robin Roberts, of "Good Morning America." Other national unveilings of his sculptures include the "Phenomenal Woman," which was presented by Oprah Winfrey to her mentor Maya Angelou, at the National Convention of the National Council of 100 Black Women.

McDowell developed several sculptor works from recent commissions that are displayed in national and state parks and universities nationwide. Unveiled at the entrance of Alabama State University in April 2006 sits a sculptor of Rosa Parks.

Although McDowell has minimal professional training, his attention to detail and multi-dimensional thinking has led to his work being found in many institutional and private collections in the U.S. and abroad. He has a strong following among the rich and famous, including Michael Jackson, Diana Ross, Smokey Robinson, Bill Cosby, Angela Bassett, Spike Lee, Dixie Carter, Brian Bosworth, Coretta Scott King, Rosa Parks, Dorothy Height, Barry Gordy, Jr., Maya Angelou, former President Bill Clinton, and LL Cool J to name a few.

McDowell's work is greatly diversified and includes film, sculpture, painting, commercial art, murals and illustrations. Of his expression, he says: "I honor the gift God gave me. This isn't about me I'm [being used] to tell a story of a time, a place and a people."

In fact, McDowell sacrificed his childhood and much of his adult life to hone his craft. He creates with a purpose a higher calling to teach and minister love. It is this dedication and passion to the craft that has been the driving force behind his philanthropic efforts to educate the public about the arts. It is his belief that every person should understand art so they can appreciate and see the beauty in it.

He is especially concerned about the disadvantage community and the lack of art programs available to the youth in low-income neighborhoods and disadvantaged areas. "We need more positiviv leaders who will help promote art and it's importance in the [black] community," McDowell stated. As an advocate of the arts, McDowell volunteers at art programs and coordinates seminars to help promote the craft. He is also a professor at the University of Alabama, teaching the History of Art.

As an African-American artist, McDowell considers himself a public servant to his community. He is committed to telling truthful stories of black life and love through his works. While other artists may only hint at the truth, McDowell creates with a conviction and passion that is undeniable. "My work speaks of who I am and the world I live in," he affirmed.

Simply put, McDowell's goal is to give the gift of love through art.
